SUBJECT: Fiscal Intermediary Shared System (FISS) - Create Utility to Update Reason Code File to Remove Deleted Codes

I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES: The purpose of this Change Request (CR) is to implement changes in FISS to allow batch deletes on the FISS reason code file where the code has been removed and the reason code is not valid. FISS has done extensive research on the reason code file and found a large number of records that can be deleted. Manual removal of the records is possible using the PF12 delete function but would require FISS and the Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) to make mass updates in every production/test region and would require a large manual effort.

This CR will create a reusable FISS utility to remove specified records from the reason code file. The utility will function like the manual PF12 delete, but reduce the amount of effort required to make mass updates to the reason code file. FISS will specify the reason codes to be removed when the utility is run and create a validation report for the MACs. This CR will address approximately the first 100 records identified for deletion. Additional CRs will be issued to update the utility and delete the remaining records.

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I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: The FISS reason code file currently has over 20,000 unique reason codes. Over the years, codes became obsolete but the record was not removed from the file. The result is a large number of reason codes that are no longer assigned. The unnecessary records should be deleted to improve processing efficiency and prevent confusion or unnecessary maintenance.

FISS has been working on in-depth analysis of the records on the reason code file and has found a large number of reason code records where the FISS code to assign the reason code has been removed and the reason code cannot be assigned. FISS and the MACs could remove the reason codes using the PF12 delete function, but this would be a huge manual effort to update every test and production region.

B. Policy: There is no policy impact.
